

REQUEST TO TEMPORARILY TRANSFER VOTERS TO ADJACENT PRECINCT MUNICIPAL ELECTION

G.S. § 163-128: Upon a resolution adopted by the county board of elections and approved by the Executive Director of the State Board of Elections voters from a given precinct may be temporarily transferred, for the purpose of voting, to an adjacent precinct.

A separate form must be completed for each municipality.

Upon a resolution adopted by the county board of elections . . . voters from a given precinct may be temporarily transferred, for the purpose of voting, to an adjacent precinct.

CBE Resolution was adopted on Aug 22 2017

When such a resolution has been adopted by the county board of elections to assign voters from more than one precinct to the same precinct, then the county board of elections shall maintain separate registration and voting records, . . . , so as to properly identify the precinct in which such voters reside.

- Ballots will be coded by style and true precinct will be recorded on ballots
- Ballots will be coded by precinct

The board shall give **45 days'** notice thereof prior to the next primary or election
(Check to confirm all methods of notice that you will use to comply with this requirement):

- Notice shall be given by advertisement in a newspaper having general circulation in the county;
- by posting a copy of the resolution at the courthouse door and at the office of the county board of elections;
- and by mailing a copy of the resolution to the chairman of every political party in the county.
- Notice will additionally be made on a radio or television station or both, but such notice shall be in addition to the newspaper and other required notice.

No later than 30 days prior to the primary or election, the county board of elections shall mail a notice of precinct change to each registered voter who as a result of the change will be assigned to a different voting place.

- Absentee voting is allowed by municipality

Whereas, The Town of Snow Hill, NC is incorporated within 2 precincts - Snow Hill #1 and Bear Garden;
and

Whereas, the Town of Snow Hill municipal voter registration in Snow Hill #1 precinct is 1,088 voters and
voter registration in Bear Garden precinct is 37; and

Whereas, in past municipal elections the Greene County Board of Elections has moved voters from the
Bear Garden precinct to the Snow Hill #1 precinct; and


Whereas, the Board of Elections supplies the voter registration list of Bear Garden voters to the Snow
Hill #1 precinct; and

Whereas, all affected Bear Garden voters will be notified of any polling place changes with a detailed
map of the temporary polling place change along with a copy of an absentee request form; and


Whereas, any polling place change will be advertised in the local newspaper, posted at the Courthouse
and a copy of the change mailed to each party chair;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Greene County Board of Elections does hereby by unanimous vote
temporarily move the 37 Town of Snow Hill voters in the Bear Garden precinct to the Snow Hill #1
precinct for the 2017 municipal election;
