

NOTICE OF ELECTION /ABSENTEE MEETING/POLLING PLACE CHANGE

An election will be held on November 7, 2017, in the Town of Hookerton, N. C., Town of Snow Hill, N. C., Town of Walstonburg, N. C., and in the Maury, NC Sanitary Land District. In Hookerton a mayor and two town commissioners will be elected. In Snow Hill a mayor and three town commissioners will be elected. In Walstonburg a mayor and five town commissioners will be elected. In the Maury Sanitary Land District three board members will be elected. The polls will be open for voting on that day from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. The polling place for the Town of Hookerton is the Hookerton Fire Station. The polling place for the Town of Snow Hill is the Snow Hill Fire Station. Snow Hill residents in the Bear Garden precinct will be temporarily moved to the Snow Hill Fire Station for this election only. The polling place for the Town of Walstonburg is the Walstonburg Fire Station. The polling place for the Maury Sanitary Land District is the Maury Fire Station.

Residents of these municipalities or Maury Sanitary Land District, who are registered to vote with the Greene County Board of Elections, may vote in the election. Those residents of these municipalities or Maury Sanitary Land District who are not registered to vote must register by October 13, 2017, to be eligible to vote in this election. Also, any voter who has moved since the last election must notify the Board of Elections of that change by the same date. A person may register to vote at the Greene County Board of Elections Office or pick up the forms from the County Board of Elections Office, the public library, and the town halls. Voter registration forms may be printed from the State Board of Elections website-www.ncsbe.gov, completed, and mailed or delivered to the County Board of Elections Office. All registration applications must be postmarked or delivered to the county board of elections office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 13, 2017. The Elections Board Office is located at 110 SE First Street, Snow Hill, N. C. Alternatively, same day registration is allowed at early voting for those who miss the registration deadline.

Absentee ballots will be permitted in said elections. The voter may apply for an absentee ballot beginning October 8, 2017. The application for absentee ballots must be made in person or in writing by the voter, a near relative, or verifiable legal guardian to the Greene County Board of Elections. The deadline for applying for an absentee ballot to be mailed to voter is 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, October 31, 2017. "One-Stop" absentee voting will be held in the Greene County Board of Elections Office at 110 SE First Street in Snow Hill, N. C. beginning Thursday, October 19, 2017, and ending on Saturday, November 4, 2017, at 1:00 p.m. One-Stop voting hours during this period at the Greene County Board of Elections Office are 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. on Monday through Friday; and 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 4, 2017. The Greene County Board of Elections will meet at 7:00 p.m. in the Greene County Board of Elections Office on October 17, 24, 31, November 6 and November 13 for the purpose of approving absentee ballot applications/ballots. Canvass Day will be held at 11:00 a.m. in the Greene County Board of Elections Office in Snow Hill on November 17, 2017.

Registration facilities and polling places in all precincts are accessible to the elderly and handicapped. In the event that polling places cannot be made accessible, elderly and handicapped voters may vote ballots at curbside or request assignment to an accessible facility for the purpose of voting.

Instructions on casting ballots printed in large type will be displayed at each polling place. Blind, disabled, and illiterate voters may ask for and receive assistance in casting votes from the person of his or her choice.
